*John A. Cavanagh was a founding member of the Contractors' Association of Greater New York, Inc. (CAGNY) and was elected Chairman Emeritus of CAGNY in 2004, having served as CAGNY's Chairman since the association's founding in 1984. John also served as Chairman of the New York Building Congress from 1996 to 2000, as a Director and Director Emeritus for decades, and was a Vice Chairman of the New York Building Foundation. John served three terms as President of New York's Building Trades Employers' Association (BTEA) and subsequently as BTEA's Chairman Emeritus and a member of its Board of Directors. John Cavanagh was one of the earliest construction industry supporters of Nontraditional Employment for Women (NEW) and helped open doors throughout the industry for tradeswomen trained by NEW. He was also a founding and current board member of the Edward J. Malloy Initiative on Construction Skills, Inc. (formerly Construction Skills 2000) since its inception in 2000.*

*In sum, John Cavanagh was recognized for his entire career and throughout the New York City construction industry as an active and dedicated leader, trusted as an authority by all sectors of the building community. He was a good man, a good citizen and a great leader.*
